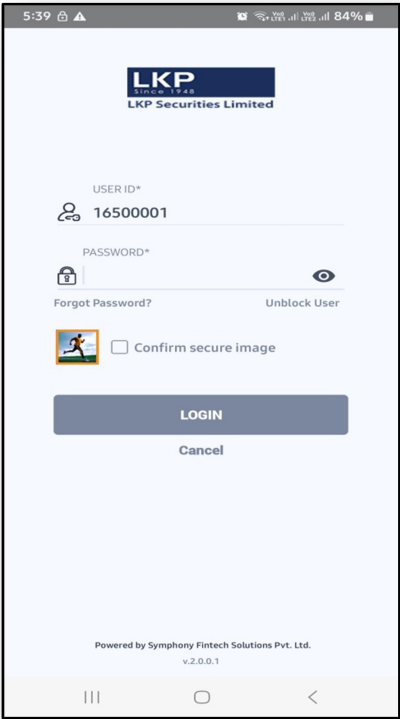
Introduction to GetSetGrow

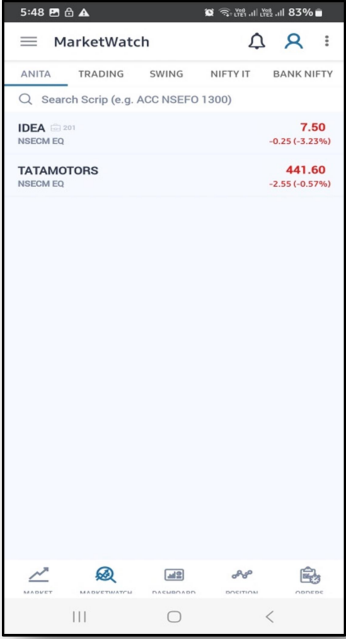

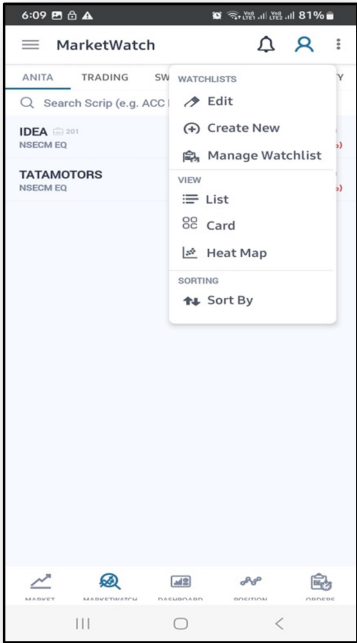

 - Volume

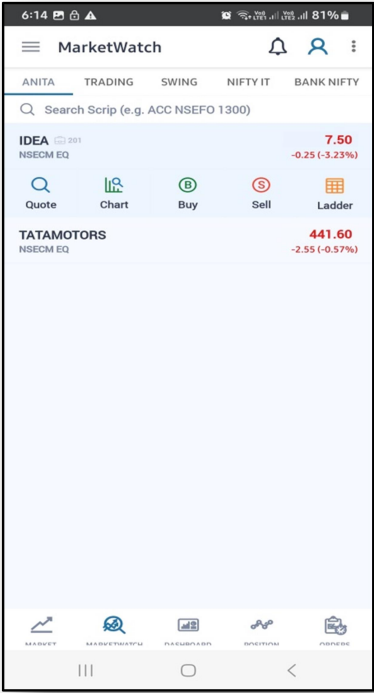

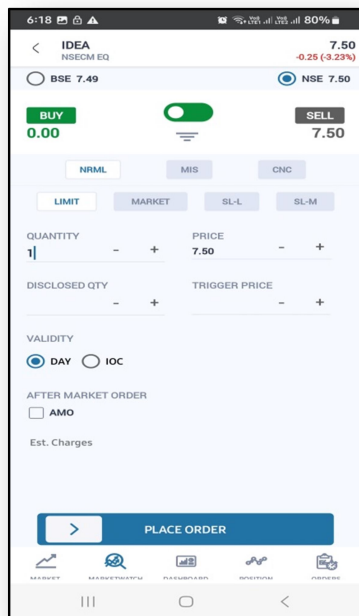

PLACE ORDER


- Action: Select buy or sell from the dropdown provided for buying or selling security or contract.
- Prod. Code: Select the product types from the dropdown:
 - CNC (Cash and Carry or Delivery Order)
 - MIS (Margin Intraday Square off)
 - NRML (Normal or Trading order)
 - CO (Cover Order)
 - BO (Bracket Order)
- Qty: Enter the desired quantity to be bought or sold.
- Order Type: Select order type like limit order, market order, and stop loss limit (SL) or stop loss market (SL-M) order as provided in the combo box.
- Dis. Qty: It is an optional field. Out of the total quantity ordered, enter the quantity that is to be disclosed while order is open at exchange. Disclosed quantity has to be minimum 10% of the total quantity entered.
- Limit Price: Enter the price at which the above quantity and security/contract is to be bought or sold.
- Validity: Application facilitates entering orders with various time conditions attached as supported by the exchange.
 - Day: Validity up to trading hours
 - IOC: Immediate or Cancel
 - Trigger price: This field is enabled only when the stop loss order type is selected. It should be noted that for a buy order, the trigger price should always be less than the limit price and for a sell order the trigger price should always be greater than the limit price.

Dashboard



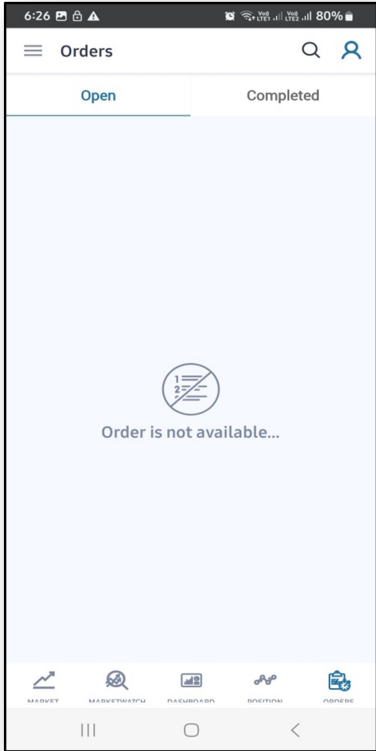
- To view the cash deposits or available cash margin, click on “Balances” from the dashboard.
- The limits set at different levels for the investor client is seen as a dropdown in the Balances window and the RMS Sub limits of each level displays the following fields:
 - Cash Available
 - Collateral
 - Margin Utilized
 - Net Margin Available
- Click on Details to view the detailed limits segregated into the following three parts:
 - Margin available: displays total cash component
 - Margin utilized: displays total margin used on open orders and position
 - RMS limits: displays the net balance

Position

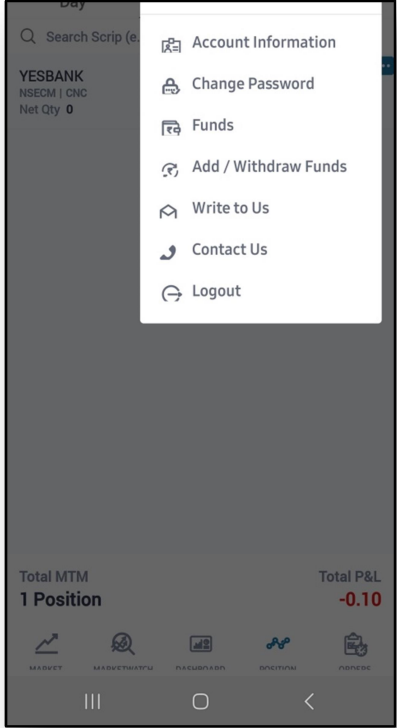


- Positions window gives a consolidated scrip wise view of the investor client's trades.
- All position can be squared in a single click. To square of all position select the day wise position or net wise position and click on square off all button.
- Pop up will ask the confirmation to square off all positions

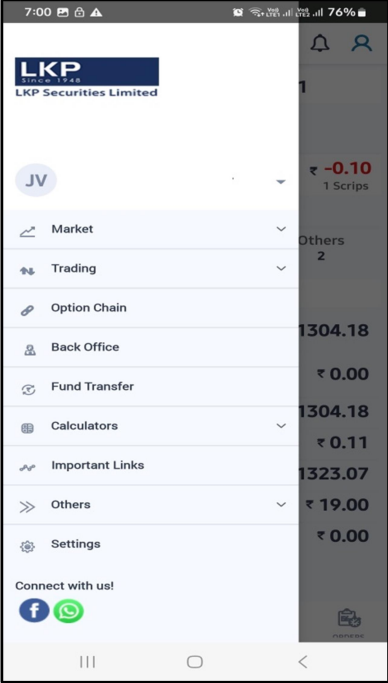

Funds



- **Pay-In**
 - Investor client can transfer fund from his/her bank account to member's bank account by using online payment facility. Online payment is initiated, if clients and member have bank a/c with the same bank. Once the funds are transferred to member's bank a/c, cash limit is updated on real time basis in Position.
 - To Transfer funds click on "Right side Menu bar > Add/ Withdraw Funds". Enter the deposit amount, select the segment where limit to be given and select the bank account from amount should deduct.
 - Select the payment gateway from the payment type.
- **Pay-Out**
 - Investor Client can request for payout funds by using the payout facility. For funds pay out click on "Rights side Menu bar > Add/ Withdraw Funds"
 - The Maximum withdrawal limit value (Cash Available + Pay-in Amount – Margin consumed – Payout Amount) of the investor client is displayed.
 - Status of the successful transaction can be view in Status tab. To view the status of the transaction click on "Left side Menu bar > Add/ Withdraw Funds"

- It is used to calculate cost of carry or future price for future instruments in NFO, CDS, BFO, BCD, MCX, MCX-SX, MSEFO& NCDEX segment.
- Select valuation based on LTP, bust buy or sell price
- Select Cost of carry or future price and click on 'Calculate' button to compute
- Option Calculator
- It is used to calculate theoretical call & put option price for index and stock option contracts in BSE F&O, BSE CDS segment.
- Select the Option Calculator from 'MENU > Calculator>Options'
- Select equity price or future price or lower of the equity or future prices as spot rate for calculating option price.
